## Speed Survey – Frieth

The strips were placed and worked for 24 hours a day from Friday 08/12/23 to Friday 15/12/23.

There were 8722 vehicles recorded in total, of which 6142 were classed as type 2, which are passenger cars. There were 2no 6 or more axle trucks (single trailer), which was the largest vehicle type recorded.

The fastest recorded was a vehicle on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> January travelling 50 – 55mph between 10-11 am.

Vehicles were recorded travelling between 40 – 45mph on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> one between 12-1pm and one 7-8pm, one on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> between 9-10am, and one on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> between 7-8pm.

The data shows that 2.8% of cars during the survey were travelling at a speed of over 35 mph.

The hours with the most volume of traffic were at school pick up and drop off times, with the majority of this traffic between travelling at a speed of between 10 and 35 mph.
